COPY OF LETTER FROM Mr. A. A. P. Neave, Encl 7 in M. P. 798/22.

1st February, 1923.

Sir,

With reference to the survey of Stanley which I have carried out recently, I beg to request that the tracing which

I am packing in tin cylinder in box may be sent home this mail for the purpose of having a number of prints taken off by lithograph or photolithograph process (i.e. black lines on a white background) and that the tracing may be returned with the prints from home at the earliest possible date.

I estimate that I shall probably require about 2 dozen copies in connection with the various sections of the Stanley improvement scheme. In addition to this quantity you may wish to add a further number for local use, which I presume would not be charged to the Improvement vote.

I would suggest that the number under this heading should not exceed say 12 months requirements as it may prove desirable to make a few minor alterations or additions to the tracing at a later date (e.g. notation of selected spot levels etc:) when I can spare time from the preparation of portions of the actual Improvement Schemes, which are at the present of greater importance; the plan prepared being sufficiently detailed for my own requirements as the basis for this work.

I need scarcely add that this survey, which has taken a very considerable amount of time to carry out, is absolutely essential to the preparation of any adequate and comprehensive scheme or report and that without such plan as a basis on which it would be impossible to design properly any of the works contemplated. On completion of the levelling and plotting of various sections of the district, with which I am now occupied, I shall be in a position to proceed with the design of actual works and the preparation of the reports desired.
