Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that owing to the pressing need for economy it has been decided to reduce to the lowest possible limits the issue of complimentary copies of Admiralty charts and Sailing Directions.

At present, new charts, new editions of charts and large corrections to existing charts of the Falkland islands, South Georgia and the Antarctic are supplied to you as published, together with new editions of the South America Pilot, Parts I & II and the Antarctic Pilot and relative supplements.

I regret that in future it will not be possible to continue the free supply of the charts mentioned above. If you consider, however, that it is essential that future issues should be supplied the necessary arrangements can be made by this Department for supply on repayment.

As regards the Sailing Directions no further gratuitous issues will be made by this Department but if you consider that a continued
