MINUTES.

It. Charts and plans of record do not appear to have been very carefully looked after in the past. For many years these documents were kept in the Surveyors Office and on abolition of that office the documents remained in what was then known as the Government Office. I believe Sir Wm Grey-Wilson had the documents collected and removed to Govt. House.

Many references are made in the principal land record book, i.e., the Crown Grant book to Charts and plans but in many instances these have not been found. No doubt in the past such documents have been borrowed and either mislaid or lost. The Chart dealing with the boundaries of Laponia is a case in point. Search has from time to time been made for this very important document but without result. I am glad to say however that it was found a few days ago in this office.

Subsequent Paper.

2. All land records with the exception of the lease books are in the custody of the Registrar General and it seems to me a matter of paramount importance that all charts and plans relating to land should also be in the custody of that office. I understand that a number of such records were handed over to the P. W. Dept., - these should be handed over to the Registrar General.

3. I sent the chart of Lafonia to J. K. to see.

Any charts or plans you have in your office should in due course be handed over to the Registrar-General. This applies only to documents dealing with Country or suburban land and not with the Town of Stanley of which there is already a plan in the Registrar's office.

2. Prior to handing over such charts a suitable cabinet for their filing will be required. There is such a cabinet in the Treasurer's office and this may be placed in the Registrar's office, but a suitable table will be required in its place. You might kindly examine the cabinet and see whether some locking device can be fitted.
