

- 2. San Carlos Sheep Farming Co. Ltd (not C.S. Sheep Farming Co. Ltd. occupy the land. Owner Estate G. Bonner.
- Teal Inlet Limited occupy the land. Owner Estate
 J. J. Felton.
- 4. Brown should read Browning.
- 5. Mrs. G. Yonge should read Mrs. F.O.S. Yonge.
- 6. J. Lee should read J.W.T. Lee.
- 7. J. Davis should read J.J. Davis.
- 8. Jason West Cay, Jason East Cay, The Fridays, Flat Jason, Seal Rocks, North Fur Island, Elephant Jason, South Jason, South Fur Island, Gibraltar Rock and two small islands to the West of Carcass Island are Crown Lands.
- 9. Sedge Island and Wreck Island are owner by J.W.T. Lee, G.A. Sornsen and M.J. McMullen.
- O. West Point Island, Low Island and Dunbar Islands are owned by R.B. Napier.
- 1. Split Island falls within the Passage Islands group and is owned by John Hamilton Ltd.
- 2. There are two areas in the vicinity of Mengeary Point and Weir Creek which are Crown Lands leased to R.J.C. Bundes.
- 13. Great Island, Swan Island and North Swan Island are all owned by the F. I.Co.
- 14. Cliff Island (Port North) is Crown Land.
- 15. Hill Gap Island (Falkland Sound) is Crown Land.
- 16. Sea Dog Island, Bird Island and Arch Islands are Crown Lands.
- 17. Government It (Pebble group) is Crown Land.
- 18. There is an area of 1,000 acres of Crown Land at the Fox Bay East settlement.
- 19. Bobs Island (not Babs Island) in Port Salvador is owned by Douglas Station Ltd.
- 20. High Island in Port Salvador is held by Teal Inlet Ltd.
- 21. Green Island, Centre Island, Shag Island, Ear Island and other islands in Port Salvador have not been granted to any person or corporation, but I understand some of the farmers in this area make use of these islands. Crown Lands, unless the occupiers can prove otherwise.
- 22. North West Islands (Falkland Sound) are probably used by San Carlos Sheep Farming Co., but they not included in the Crown Grant for San Carlos. Crown Lands.
- J.L. Waldron Ltd., but are not included in the Crown Grant for Port Howard. Crown Lands unless the occupier is able to prove otherwise.
- Long Island (Berkeley Sound), Pleasant Island (Port Pleasant) and Elephant Island and Burnt Island (Kelp Lagoon) are not included in the Crown Grant to the Falkland Islands Co. Ltd. but Kidney Island is specifically excluded.
- 25. The Albemarle area opposite the Arch Islands forms an enclave of Crown Land leased to the F.I.Co. within the area owned by the F.I.Co.

From time to time maps produced by this Directorate and sent in bulk for use by the local Government, become known to the general public locally and a demand for their sale may be made.

There is no objection to such sales, but if you contemplate making any, care should be taken beforehand to ensure that sufficient copies are retained for the use of the local Government (including Departments other than your own); these copies which are printed free, should be marked "Official Use Only" and not sold to the public, since this Directorate's maps normally have a selling price printed on them. When it is proposed to place on sale to the public maps which do not have a selling price printed upon them, each copy should be priced and stamped "For sale, price.....".

A careful record should be kept of all such sales of maps produced by this Directorate. Since all copies of these sheets have been given without charge to your Department for the use of the local Government, the money received from such sales should be returned to this Directorate, less a reasonable percentage for the cost of recording sales. A percentage of 20% is regarded as reasonable, and this money becomes part of the revenue of the local Government, in the same way as the money returned by you goes in H.M. Government funds. There is no objection to such receipts being paid quarterly or half yearly, through the Grown Agents for Oversea Governments and Administrations, made payable to the Paymaster General. Details of sales should be sent direct to the Establishment and Finance Officer, Directorate of Overseas Surveys, at the same time as the Crown Agents are asked to make payment. Requirements for further supplies of maps to meet such sales should be made to the Records Officer of the Directorate. Supplies of maps of other territories produced and printed by this Directorate should be purchased direct from Messrs. E. Stanford Limited, 12-14, Long Acre, London W.C.2.

"We appreciate that some farms will extend across two or more 1:50,000 sheets but it is regretted that we cannot undertake to cut and join sets of sheets to cover farms for their owners. Farm owners or managers should be advised that they should purchase a set of the published maps covering their farms and make their own arrangements for triuming them and sticking them together. (This can be done quite easily with a razor blade and a plastic adhesive such as "Cov" but if mounted and varmished wall maps are wanted, then it would probably be necessary to get a United Mingdom firm such as Stanford to undertake this)."

It is always necessary to show some water areas in dark blue because very small water areas would not be readily readible if they were shown by a stipple or half tone, i.e. light blue. technical reasons we generally use a stipple which is fitted inside a line surrounding the water area. The draughtsman fills in small areas solidly and draws a line round larger areas when making the drawing for the blue plate.

This being so it is necessary to have a minimum sized area for the stipple, but, you will appreciate, it would be a waste of time for this to be applied as an absolute standard. It is therefore used as a guide, the individual draughtsman's judgement being the deciding factor, with the result that there are slight variations. You will, I am sure, be able to find a patch of dark blue larger than a patch of light blue. But the rule is small areas dark blue and larger areas light blue. We usually make this clear by showing Ponds in dark (or solid) blue and Lakes in stipple (or light blue) in the reference and I apologise that this has not been done in the case of the Falkland Islands Series.

I was interested in your suggestion that the swall map of the Falkland Islands (D.O.S. 30/1) which is now frequently used for Annual Reports and other similar purposes should be amended to be an outline geographical map only. I agree with your suggestion and would ask that you go ahead with arrangements for this to be done.

I think you will agree that it would not be sufficient merely to delete the principle property boundaries and the names of their owners or lessees because this would make the map look extremely bare. I suggest that certain hill features should be included. We would, of course, like to see the result of your efforts before the new map was published.

I was sorry to read that no official decision had yet been made about your visit to the Falkland Islands and I look forward to hearing in December that you will be able to come and stay with us. This Colony most certainly needs to have someone in the Colonial Office who has visited it and has some idea of local conditions. I plan that you should spend as much time as possible when you come in visiting a number of farms representative of life in the Colony as well as spending time meeting people here in Stanley.

I was glad to know that your mother's health had improved. It must have been very worrying for you at the time when we met in London and I hope that her good progress continues.

We had an extremely pleasant voyage out here and since our arrival we have been kept very busy. People have been extremely friendly and helpful to us and we are very much enjoying being here.



Gibraltar Rook

Mr. R. Napier of West Point Island has raised the question of ownership of Gibraltar Rock and two small islands (rocks) nearby claiming that they are his property but appear on the new maps as Crown Land. Mr. Napier states that Gibraltar Rocks were sold to him, along with West Point Island, by Bertrand and Felton Limited.

The Registrar General refutes the claim on the grounds that Gibraltar Rocks were not the property of Bertrand and Felton Limited and sould not, therefore, form part of the sale referred to by Mr. Napler.

The question arises as to whether Government might wish to sell these rocks to Mr. Napier. They are of very little use as farming land. Mr. Napier's main interest in then comes from his long belief that he owned them. The rocks also have an abundance of wild life in which Mr. Napier is also known to be interested.

Mr. Napier has expressed interest in purchasing the Rocks.
