It is hereby notified, for general information, that with the object of securing the better preservation of the tribes of Gentoo penguins in the neighbourhood of Stanley no permits will be granted during the coming season for the collection of Gentoo penguin eggs from the Rookeries at Sparrow Cove and at Mount Lowe.

Any unauthorised person found taking eggs or in possession of eggs taken from the Gentoo penguin rookeries at Sparrow Cove and at Mount Lowe will be liable to prosecution with the full rigour of the law.
