Your Excellency,

In making this application to you through H.M.Consul of Punta Arenas, I hope to obtain your sanction and permission to take the sailing schooner "Diana" of 80 tons register sealing in Falkland Waters , also to obtain your sanction to the erection of a seal oil refining works.

We can run to Port Stanley from Punta Arenas with timber grain etc. periodically, and in the season round the Islands.

I am discharged En gineer from H.M. Navy and have seen service in the North Sea with the Dover Patrol, also in Flanders with the R.N.D.

My small remaining capital is staked in this scheme whose success depends upon the sanction of Your Excellency.
