S E A L I N G L I C E N C E .

Under the provisions of Section 5 of the Seal Fishery (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1921, a licence subject to the conditions set forth below is hereby granted to

MR. CECIL WILLIAM WICKHAM BERTRAND

to take SEA LION, ELEPHANT SEAL and SEA LEOPARDS on the ARCH ISLANDS, WEST FALKLAND ISLANDS.

C O N D I T I O N S .

1. This licence is valid from the 1st April, 1947 and will expire on the 1st December, 1947.
2. Not more than 250 Lion, 20 Elephant and 12 Leopard may be killed.
3. Only adult males (bulls) may be killed.
4. At least ten per cent of the adult males shall be left alive.
5. Immature males, females, and pups shall not be molested.
6. Killing shall be done in a speedy and humane manner.
7. There shall be no waste in the utilisation of the seal.
8. At the end of the operation a report shall be made to the Colonial Secretary and shall include a return of the number of seals killed and of the oil production in gallons as well as of the total number of Elephant Seals seen with details of sex, and age so far as these can be ascertained and of the effects of the killings on the survivors.
9. The issue of this licence is subject to the prepayment of a fee of ten pounds (£10).
10. Export Duty shall be paid at the rate of one shilling and sixpence per forty gallons of oil produced.
11. This licence is not transferable.
