
Owning to continued failures of plant it has still not been possible to process more than a token quantity of the residues from the digesters, and this continues to be stored in a dump near to the factory.

You will note that it has not been possible to give an average production per seal, as the greater part of the oil expressed was still in process at the date of the return.

Owing to pressure of work no experimental work has been done on livers, but it is hoped to originate this in the month of Sept.


