Introduction to the Collections Guide



The Collections Guide has been developed to provide a detailed outline of the collections and records preserved by the Jane Cameron National Archives. This information can be used by researchers and service users to understand what types of subjects, material, and records are accessible to them, and can be used to identify records that users may want to access in person from the Archives, or if a digital copy is available.

The Guide does not provide a full itemised list of all catalogued and accessible archival records but is intended to provide a useful starting point for anyone researching Falkland's history through the service. Researchers can use the Collections Guide to examine what records are retained by the Archives, how many items exist within a particular collection or series level (indicating topics and subject matters), the date range that the records cover, and the accessibility of the records.

Accessibility of Material

In the majority, all collections listed in the Collections Guide are accessible to the public. There may be exceptions if a record contains personal data, sensitive content, or if access restrictions have been agreed as per terms of the transfer to the Archives.

The Collections Guide indicates whether material has been digitised, and if a digital copy exists either online or through the service. Not all records in a complete series levels are digitised, and some collections may be partially digitised meaning that a selection of material is available digitally. Links to website pages have been provided at the start of every section, and the Collection Guide is to be used in conjunction with the JCNA website itself, to enable researchers to proactively search for and access digital material in our Online Collections: <https://nationalarchives.gov.fk/>

All items, unless advised by the JCNA, are accessible in person from the Archives during archive appointments.

Is this all the material the Archives has?

No. This does not include uncatalogued items. The Archives are continually receiving and cataloguing new accessions and material. 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1 Falkland Islands Government Collection

1.1 Early Manuscripts & Government Records

Records and early manuscripts of the Government and British administration have been partially digitised, as indicated below, and are available to view on the JCNA website at: <https://nationalarchives.gov.fk/online-collections/government>

Miscellaneous Documents from Government House Consist of certain highly valued items traditionally kept in Government House for safe keeping but recently transferred to the Archives. They include the earliest manuscript in the Islands, Captain Smyley's appointment as Branch Pilot, signed by Vernet and dated November 1831. Other notable items in the Government House collection include a manuscript of Thomas Helsby's account of the Port Louis murders and the census document for 1851. There are also many Letters Patent from the British Crown, often elaborate parchment documents, some with heavy wax seals, providing for the Government of the Falkland Islands and Dependencies. This also includes a large leather-bound volume titled Governor's Notes [E19], started in 1899 by Governor Grey-Wilson, containing miscellaneous material of local relevance, kept up sporadically by some later governors including Allardyce and Middleton. There are eight Visitors Books together covering the periods February 1935 to September 1946, April 1954 to January 1957 and May 1967 to August 2006. Gazettes These are copies of the handwritten Gazette notices which were pinned up on the Government Notice Board in Stanley for public information before printed Gazettes began to be regularly issued from 1st January 1891. Before this date only occasional sheets were issued in printed form. (NB The first notice in Gazette No. 1 Volume 1 reads "In consequence of the destruction of the Government Official Gazette Board on which it has been customary to publish both official and private Notices, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to authorize the issue of a Government Gazette by authority.") Gazette (E05) contains originals of the Stanley Advertisement Sheet. This was a weekly single sheet publication printed by John Nixon, the government printer, containing public notices and advertisements. On the fourth issue the title changed to "Stanley Government Gazette". Only five issues are known to exist, the last dated 28th June 1870. The Gazettes continue to the present day across multiple media formats. Blue Books The Blue Books were produced annually and contain statistical records for the Falkland Islands. They were called Blue Books simply because the forms to be filled in were printed on blue paper. They listed names, salaries and dates of appointment of everyone working for government and information on trade, shipping, land use, schools and local organizations. Believed to have been issued for the Falkland Islands between 1846 and 1944, there should be ninety-nine volumes in total. The current Archive collection is incomplete, having about thirty volumes missing, mainly from the 19th century. Oath of Office Books These six volumes recorded oaths of office taken by individuals such as members of Legislative and Executive Councils, Governors, Colonial Secretaries, judges and other senior civil servants. Executive Council Minute Books There are eight original manuscript volumes. The first meeting was in 1845. The first volume of Executive Council minutes is missing and the explanation can be found at the beginning of the second volume where a note reads "Volume 1 of the minutes of the Executive Council was lost in the wreck of the "Levenside" at the entrance of Port William." The Levenside was a British barque that had been collecting guano from New Island. She was returning to Stanley to land Governor Rennie, who had taken the opportunity to visit West Falkland (and was carrying official papers, clearly hoping to do some office work on the voyage). On the night of the 26 of January 1852 the Levenside struck on the Billy Rock and foundered in Port William. Everyone on board was saved but the ship was a total loss. While the British Antarctic Territory is now administered from Britain, the Governor of the Falkland Islands is also the Commissioner for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands and the administration of these is based in Stanley.

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9 Falkland Islands Association Collection

An association formed in Britain to lobby the British Government for the Falklands' right to self-determination. In 1968 the UK FI Committee (FI Emergency Committee as it was originally entitled) was formed following a direct appeal from Legislative Council to House of Commons over concerns about negotiations between British and Argentine Governments which could lead to the transfer of sovereignty of the Islands. The Committee was reformed in 1972 as the Falkland Islands Committee, with the UKFIC setting objectives in 1973 that were further revised in 1976 upon the release of Shackleton's Report that advised the organisation should establish an office in London (done in 1977 by the Association under the name "The Falklands Islands Office"), and bring together all interested in the future of the Falkland Islands into one Association. The Falkland Islands Research and Development Association Ltd (The Falkland Islands Association) was set up as a company in 1977, with members of the UKFIC being honorary members. After 1982 the Association ceased to use the name "The Falklands Islands Office", and in 1988 the UKFIC and RADA were amalgamated to act as one organisation under the Falkland Islands Association.

The Association has established multiple Committees and initiatives to support the Falkland's right to self-determination including South Atlantic Fisheries Committee (1978); United Kingdom Falkland Islands Trust (1981); Falklands Appeal (1982); Falkland Islands Foundation. A local Committee in Stanley was also set up to maintain connections and contacts across the Falkland Islands and Britain.
