The Jane Cameron National Archives is pleased to inform you that the redevelopment work on the Archives website is now complete, and the site is fully operational. This work follows months of hard work behind the scenes to gradually restructure content, add in new features, and transform the aesthetics of the site.

**Users will now find new landing pages when navigating through the ‘Online Collections’, the addition of a search bar to support accessibility and help you locate individual records based on key word searches, and revised content in the ‘About Archives’ tab providing more information about our service. Please circulate this around your Departments for their information.**

The latest newsletter (August 2025) has also been published, which showcases before/after screenshots of this work and, as usual, articles focusing on the collections of the Archives.
