The past few weeks have been focused on outreach and engagement as we have celebrated and taken part in 'Explore Your Archives Week' which ran from Saturday 29 November to Sunday 7 December.

During this time, we hosted 2 public drop-in sessions and 9 sessions for the private and public sector, with 29 people visiting the Archives and more engaging online on social media.

We were pleased to see such great engagement with our social media posts, based on the daily themes of 'Explore Your Archives' Week.
