INSTRUCTIONS FOR ROYAL VISIT.

Further to our conversation relative to the above subject, I respectfully enclose herewith copies of the instructions issued by me to :-

- a. Driver of police car.
- b. Members of the police .
- c. Naval personnel.
- d. Members of the Boys Brigade.

It was at first anticipated that 17 members of the crew of H.M.S. Protector would be allotted to us for traffic duty, but finally only 11 were lent to us.

Volunteers from the Boys Brigade then came to our assistance, and made a very good job of it.

Numbers 1 to 11 are therefore applicable to Naval personnel, and 12 to 17 to members of the Boys Brigade.

INSTRUCTIONS TO DRIVER OF POLICE VEHICLE FOR THE VISIT OF H.R.H.  
THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH ON MONDAY 7TH. AND TUESDAY 8th. JANUARY, 1957.

As the police vehicle No.333 will lead the other cars of H.R.H. the Duke of Edinburgh's entourage throughout the whole of his two day visit, the following instructions must be very carefully studied, and the routes and times strictly adhered to, so as to make the Royal visit a complete success. It must be strictly borne in mind that this is an occasion when there must be no mistakes, as one small mistake can easily upset weeks of careful planning and totally disorganise the entire arrangements for the remainder of the day.

Whilst it is fully appreciated that on both days long hours of duty will have to be performed, I am sure that you, in conjunction with all other personnel engaged upon various duties during the Royal Visit the success we wish it to be.

In addition to turning out smartly dressed on both days, you will examine your vehicle prior to commencing duty and make sure that the following are in perfect working order and mechanical condition.

Brakes - steering - lights - acceleration mechanism - windscreen wiper - sparking plugs. Oil levels will be checked, also water in radiator, petrol and speedometer.

On both days you will be accompanied by the Hon. Colonial Treasurer, the Chief Constable and Inspector Kelly, and will only take orders from any of them.

In order to adhere to your programme, your speed will have to average 15 - 20 m.p.h., the latter not to be exceeded where the local speed limit is operative.

Hand signals will be used throughout.

Your routes and times whilst actually engaged upon escort duties are as follows:-

See attached programmes No.1 for landing time at 9.30 a.m.  
No. 2 for landing at 2.00 p.m.  
No. 3 for wet weather.

Substitute for paragraphs 37 to 41 if too windy for proposed flight, on Tuesday 8th January, 1957.

You will parade for duty at the police station at 8.30 a.m. on both mornings for instructions and remain with me until dismissed. On Saturday 5th January 1957, you will collect the police vehicle at 9.0 a.m. to enable you to give it a good greasing all round and check engine, oil, water etc.
