Louis DESPREAUX was French and arrived in 1837.

Andres PETALUGA was Gibraltarian and arrived in 1837. He was listed as Capataz of Gauchos in January 1842.

Henry MITCHELL was listed as a gaicho from England in January 1842.

Antonina ROXA was listed as an occasional gaicho in January 1842.

John SCULLEY was listed as cabalareiro to the gauchos from Ireland in January 1842.

John O'NEILL was listed as major domo of gauchos from Ireland in March 1843.
