

BAILEY FAMILY (1)

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born, married, died, etc, outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands.

John BAYLEY was employed by W Keith Cameron as a shepherd and left the UK in November 1886 as a passenger on board the *Selembria* looking after 21 Cheviots for Cameron. [FIC/C2; 680]

John BAILEY and **Mary Jane LOWER**, who had been joined in marriage by an Anglican minister, were married 8 September 1888 by Patrick J Diamond, Roman Catholic Priest. Mary Jane Bailey was baptised 8 September 1888 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Her age was recorded as 27.

On 16 December 1891 John purchased Crown Grant 271 for £35 containing one rood and bordered on the north by James Street and on the south by Fitzroy Road. [BUG-REG-4; 298]

On 6 June 1894 John purchased Crown Grants 169 & 202 on James Street for £250. [BUG-REG-5; 30]

On 14 February 1896 John, a boarding house keeper, and Mary, his wife, sold Crown Grant 271 on Fitzroy Road for £60. [BUG-REG-5; 111]

On 22 June 1896 **John BAILEY** was charged with assaulting his wife and being drunk on the 20 June. [FIM Jul 1896]

Mary, age about 36 and British, died 3 July 1896 from phthisis and was buried 5 July 1896 in Grave A82. Her age was recorded as 38 in the burial and church records. In her will executed 13 May 1896 Mary devised the lot of land east of the land which her house was built upon to her Trustee John Falkland Summers to sell the land after her death and to pay all her expenses and pay off the mortgage due by her to the Falkland Islands Company Ltd. All her personal and real estate was bequeathed for the benefit of her children until the youngest reached 21 then the residue of her real estate was left to her son Robert Simpson Bailey. On 12 April 1897 John sold Crown Grants 169 and 202 for £235. [BUG-REG-5; 211]

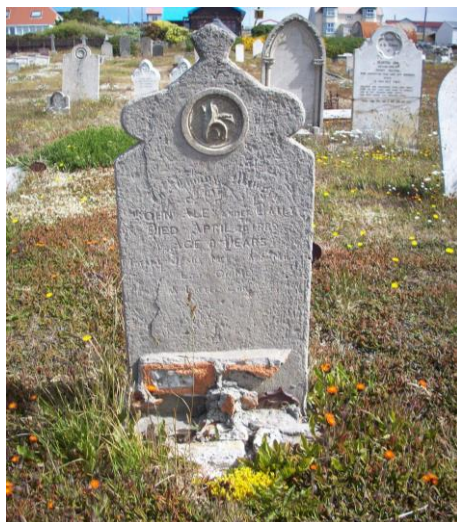
John started work for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in their Camp establishment 3 October 1901 and finished working for them 18 June 1904.

On 11 January 1904 John, a cook at Walker Creek, purchased Crown Grant 107 for £20. [BUG-REG-6; 76]

On 9 August 1904, John, a cook in Stanley, sold Crown Grant 107 for £8. [BUG-REG-6; 114]

Children of John and Mary BAILEY:

1. **John Alexander BAILEY** born 2 October 1880 (*not in the Falkland Islands*) and baptised 6 September 1888 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. John, age 8 years & 6 months, died 20 April 1889 in Stanley from acute laryngitis and was buried 20 April 1889 in Grave A83.



2. **Robert Simpson BAILEY** born 30 July 1884 (*not in the Falkland Islands*) and baptised 6 September 1888. Robert started work for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in their Camp establishment 7 March 1900 and finished working for them 4 April 1904. Robert was confirmed 6 August 190? by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. He started work for them again 12 August 1904 and finished 2 May 1908. He started work again 29 March 1909 and worked for them until 12 October 1912. Robert, a mariner, was married to **Beatrice Mabel Edith POOLE** 13 May 1914 at Christ Church Cathedral by Banns by C McDonald Hobley. Chaplain. The witnesses were Christina Maud Bailey and John A Alazia. Robert's father was recorded as John Bailey (deceased), soldier. Robert, Age 52 and a cook, died 28 March 1931 at North Arm from septicaemia following gangrene (*no burial record*). Beatrice married (2) **Christopher HAWKINS**, labourer, 2 June 1932 at the Registrar's Office, Stanley by Special Licence by G R L Brown, Registrar General. The witnesses were James A Smith and E S Smith. Beatrice and Christopher went to the UK in 1961.
3. **Henry Anthony BAILEY** born 30 July 1886 (*not in the Falkland Islands*) and baptised 6 September 1888 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Henry was confirmed 6 August 190? by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Henry started work for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in their Camp establishment 5 April 1909 and finished working for them 4 June 1913.
4. **Catherine May BAILEY** born 21 August 1888 in Stanley and baptised **Mary Catherine BAILEY** 8 September 1888 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as labourer. **Mary Catherine BAYLEY** was married to ? **PETERSEN**, sailor from Norway, in Punta Arenas. Catherine was confirmed 6 August 190? by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Mary, a widow, was married to (2) **John MATTSON**, from Sweden, in Punta Arenas.
5. **Eva Emily BAILEY** born 14 August 1890 and baptised 23 September 1890 by St Mary's Catholic Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as labourer.
6. **Christina Maud BAILEY** born 18 October 1892 and baptised 18 December 1895 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as labourer.

FIRST GENERATION:

Children of Robert and Beatrice BAILEY:

1. **Beatrice Annie Jane "Pearl" BAILEY** born 24 February 1915 in Stanley and baptised 17 March 1915 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as mariner. Married **Christopher PERRY**, shepherd, 18 May 1935 at the Deputy Registrar's Office, Fox Bay by Registrar General's Licence by William B Myles, Deputy Registrar. The witnesses were Daisy Harriet Bailey and John McDonald. Christopher died 16 February 1990 and is buried in Grave V3129. Beatrice died 25 March 2002 and is buried in Grave V3130.
2. **Regina Maud BAILEY** born 11 August 1916 in Stanley and baptised 18 September 1916 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as mariner. Regina was married to **Alfred George Reginald JOHNSON**, shepherd, 7 November 1936 at the Nonconformist Church (Tabernacle), Stanley by Special Licence by Walter Forrest McWhan, Nonconformist Minister. The witnesses were B Hawkins and Eric T Johnson. [Account of wedding Penguin 10 Nov 1936]
3. **Daisy Harriet BAILEY** born 5 February 1919 in Stanley and baptised 16 March 1919 by Christ Church Cathedral. Her father's occupation was recorded as mariner. Daisy was married to **Keith Clifford BETTS**, shepherd, 16 July 1938 at Fox Bay East by W H Clement, Justice of the Peace. The witnesses were Keith Ronald Hutchinson and Avis Marion Binnie. Daisy emigrated to the UK in 1959. Divorced 1960.
4. **Robert Terence BAILEY** born 10 September 1923 and baptised 24 September 1923 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as labourer. Robert, age 11, died 28 November 1934 from cardiac failure, mitral stenosis and acute rheumatic fever and was buried at Hill Cove.
