

## BROWN FAMILY

*NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.*

**Franklin Herbert BROWN**, seaman living at Teal Inlet, was married to **Elizabeth REIVE**, widow living at Teal Inlet, 12 October 1881 at Teal Inlet, East Falkland according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. Elizabeth signed with a X. The witnesses were Enoch Gleadell and Sarah Gleadell. Franklin's father was recorded as Samuel Brown, millwright, and Elizabeth's father was recorded as William Bateman, hatter.

Elizabeth, age 70, died 4 June 1910 and was buried 6 June 1910 in Grave Ei721. Frank, age 68 and a mariner from the United States of America, died 3 September 1910 and was buried 6 September 1910 in Grave Ei726.



## FIRST GENERATION

### Children of Franklin and Elizabeth BROWN:

1. **Mary Elizabeth BROWN** born 2 October 1882 in Stanley and baptised 15 October 1882 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Mary, age 24 days, died 26 October 1882 from inanition and was buried 29 October 1882 in Grave I550.



2. **Franklin Herbert BROWN** born 23 March 1884 in Stanley and baptised 25 May 1884 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as mariner. Frank, age 36 and a shepherd, died 12 December 1920 from influenza and pericarditis with effusion at Douglas Station and was buried there 14 December 1920.
