DRENNAN FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

Darby DRENNAN was married to **Ann CARR** (not in the Falkland Islands). Darby, a military pensioner, arrived on the *Victory* 13 October 1849 with his wife Ann and sons William and John. The family were recorded in the 1851 census as Darby, age 43, Irish pensioner and corporal; Anne, age 21, wife and Irish; William, age 4 and Irish; and John, age 2 and Irish.

FIRST GENERATION

Children of Darby and Ann DRENNAN:

- 1. **William DRENNAN** born circa 1847 (not in Falkland Islands). William arrived on the *Victory* 13 October 1849 with his parents.
- 2. **John DRENNAN** born circa 1847 *(not in Falkland Islands)*. John arrived on the *Victory* 13 October 1849 with his parents.
- 3. Mary Anne DRENNAN baptised 13 April 1851 by Holy Trinity Church.
- 4. **Ellen DRENNAN** born 3 May 1853 in Stanley. Her father's occupation was recorded as labourer and pensioner and he signed with a X.
- 5. **John DRENNAN** born 21 October 1855 in Stanley. His father's occupation was recorded as corporal of pensioners and he signed with a X.
