

DUNCAN FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.

William DUNCAN was born 21 February 1842 in Forfarshire, Scotland.

Agnes “Aggie” STEWART/STUART was born 20 March 1849 in Aberdeen, Scotland.

William was married to Agnes (*not in the Falkland Islands*).



William DUNCAN, age 23, **Agnes DUNCAN**, age 18 and **James Alexander DUNCAN**, age 1 left London at 12pm 21 July 1865 on board the “Julie Tatham”, a 327 ton English barque commanded by Joseph Cundy carrying cargo and shepherds for the Falkland Islands Company Limited. She arrived in Stanley on 22 September 1865 with 16 crew and 21½ passengers after being 62 days out.

On 6 August 1870 Frederick Cobb wrote to F Coleman in London ‘*William Duncan has undertaken to pay £15, if called upon, for the passage out of Jane Read, 24 Spittle, Old Aberdeen. She is his “good mother”, which I believe is Scotch for mother-in-law.*’ [FIC/D2; 605]

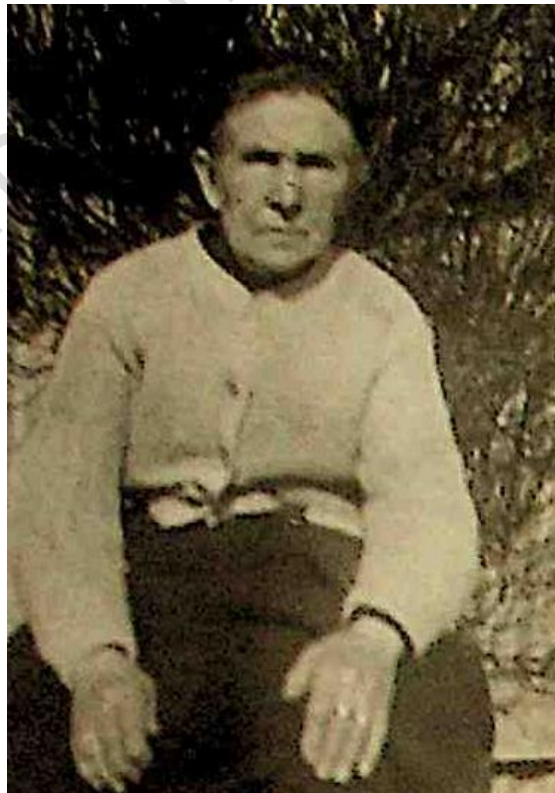
In October 1870 Frederick Cobb wrote to F Coleman in London ‘*At Norton Inlet, Duncan has another flock of ewes. This man has mended considerably during the last few years, having given up drinking to a great extent. He is, however, not a particularly clever shepherd, and can only be classed as second rate.*’ [FIC/D2; 649]

After some years working for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd the William went to work for the Waldrons at Port Howard and lived at Shag Cove. When Henry Waldron took up a lease of Beaver Island the Duncan family accompanied him.

William, age 45 and a shepherd, died on Beaver Island 17 December 1886 of cirrhosis of the liver and general blood poisoning. They dug his grave on Sunday 19 December and he was buried Monday 20 December 1886.



Agnes, age 77, emigrated to the UK in 1924 with her son George. Her height was recorded as 5' and her eyes grey/brown. [FIM Dec 1924; PPL/PPA/3]

Agnes died at 24 Highfield Road, Isleworth, Middlesex, England on 15 December 1928.

FIRST GENERATION

Children of William and Agnes DUNCAN:

1. **James Alexander “Jimmy” DUNCAN** born circa 1864 in the UK. James, age 73 & retired, died 1 January 1938 and was buried in Grave L 1118.
2. **George Stuart “Monkey” DUNCAN** born 24 September 1866 in the Falkland Islands and baptised 22 March 1867 by Holy Trinity Church. George was injured in a shooting accident on Beaver Island December 1896 [FIM Mar 1897]. George, age 57 and a shepherd, emigrated to the UK in 1924 with his mother. His height was recorded as 5' and his eyes as grey. [FIM Dec 1924; PPL/PPA/3] George, age 80, died 1 July 1948 and was buried in Grave Q 1382.



3. **Margaret Jane DUNCAN** born 13 December 1867 at Norton Inlet and baptised 14 March 1868 by Holy Trinity Church. Margaret, age 21 & living on Beaver Islands, was married to **William Thomas CANN**, age 34 and a shipwright from Plymouth living on Beaver Island, 14 November 1888 at Beaver Island according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were James A Duncan and George S Duncan. William's father was recorded as James Cann, foreman, and Margaret's father was recorded as William Duncan, Beaver Island. Margaret and William left Beaver Island for Port Stephens 28 May 1889. William, age 49, died in Stanley 16 October 1892 from heart failure and was buried 19 October 1892 in Grave A50. Margaret, age 45, and a widow, died 26 July 1912 from asthma and heart failure and is buried on Beaver Island.
4. **Anne “Annie” DUNCAN** born 23 January 1869 at Norton Inlet and baptised 8 March 1869 by Holy Trinity Church. Annie, age 18 and living on Beaver Island, was married to **John H MARKLAND**, age 29 and a silverplater living on West Point Island, 1 May 1887 at Beaver Island according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were James Alexander Duncan and Henry Waldron. John's father was recorded as William J Markland, schoolmaster, and Annie's father was recorded as William Duncan, shepherd. The family left for the UK 11 October 1904 on board the “Oruba”.
5. **Agnes DUNCAN** born 7 November 1870 at Norton Inlet and baptised 11 March 1871 by Holy Trinity Church. Agnes left the Falkland Islands 7 September 1891 on the ss “Theben” via Sandy Point, with Miss Frances Williams, John Cameron, W S Williams and Mon. Taynano. Agnes was married to **William Seccombe WILLIAMS** in London 22 October 1891. [FIM JAN 1892] William spent time farming on the Coast (South America) before successively managing

Teal Inlet, Speedwell Island and Weddell Island. William, living on Weddell Island, was appointed a Justice of the Peace in 1902. William returned to England in 1916 to see his wife and family as his daughter was ill and he died 3 May 1917 at Brighton, England. [Obituary FIM Aug 1917]



6. **Mary DUNCAN** born at 6pm 11 July 1872 at Norton Inlet. Mrs Bell helped with the birth. Mary, age 19 and living on Beaver Island, was married to **Farquhar MACRAE**, age 23 and a shepherd living on Weddell Island, 12 May 1891 in the house of Mrs Duncan, Beaver Island according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Henry Waldron and James Duncan. Farquhar's father was recorded as John Macrae, farmer, and Mary's father was recorded as William Duncan, shepherd. Farquhar committed suicide 31 January 1917 on Weddell Island and is buried there. [Obituary FIM 1917] Mary emigrated to the UK in 1927.
7. **William DUNCAN** born March 1874 at Shag Harbour, West Falkland. William, age 21 and a shepherd, died 11 November 1895 of heart disease and is buried at Port Stephens.
8. **David Henry DUNCAN** born at 4am on 8 May 1875. Mrs Belcher was there to help. At the age of 13 David went to Santa Cruz for two years. David worked at Port Stephens from 1900. David, head shepherd, was married to **Agnes HALLIDAY** 11 August 1911 at Carew Harbour, Port Stephens by J Meredith Bate, Assistant Cathedral Chaplain. The Witnesses were J Robertson and John William Jones. David's father was recorded as William Duncan, shepherd, and Agnes' father was recorded as John Halliday, shepherd. Apart from two years as overseer on Weddell Island, David worked at Port Stephens until retirement. Agnes, age 62, died 28 July 1955 and was buried 30 July 1955 in Grave Q 1555. In old age David returned to Carew Harbour to live with his daughter Helen. David, age 86 and a shepherd, died 28 November 1961 at Carew Harbour at the home of his daughter. (*buried at Port Stephens?*)
9. **Helen Esson DUNCAN** born at 20 minutes to 8 o'clock 17 August 1876 and baptised 23 April 1877 by Holy Trinity Church. Helen, age 26 and living in Stanley, was married to **James GREIG**, age 34 and a mariner living in Stanley, 6 June 1902 in the parsonage according to the Rites & Ceremonies of the Established Church by Licence by Lowther E Brandon MA Dean & Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Betsy Humble, Mary Willis and Isabella Fraser Watson. James' father was recorded as James Greig, clerk, and Helen's father was recorded as William Duncan, shepherd. Left for Liverpool on board the "Panama" 4 February 1903 with a child (Lionel).
10. **Elizabeth Lucie DUNCAN** born 11 September 1877 and baptised 24 November 1880 by Holy Trinity Church. Elizabeth was married to **Angus McLEOD** (*not in Falklands*), a shepherd.
11. **John Murray "Jack" DUNCAN** born at 4am on Thursday 24 October 1878 on Beaver Island and baptised 24 November 1880 by Holy Trinity Church. Lived on Beaver Island for 56 years.

Collapsed and died Sunday 6 February 1944 as he was walking along Davis Street on the way to the service at the Tabernacle. [FI Weekly News 10 Feb 1944] John, age 65, was buried in Grave P 1265.

12. **Rachel Moriah DUNCAN** born at 11pm on Friday 26 December 1879 and baptised 24 November 1880 by Holy Trinity Church. Married **George Thomas STEWART**, a 20 year old shepherd living in Stanley but late of New Island, 18 June 1903 at the house of Mr Etheridge, Stanley by Special Licence by C K Blount MA Assistant Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Helen Etheridge and John Summers. They left for Liverpool on board the *Oropesa* 28 June 1903. In July 1905 they were living in Moose Jaw, North West Territories, Canada. Rachel died 9 October 1911 at Pembina, North Dakota, USA. [FIM Mar 1912]



13. **Peter Reid DUNCAN** born 17 June 1882 at Beaver Island and baptised in 1885 by Holy Trinity Church. Peter, age 82 and a shepherd, died in Stanley 21 September 1964 was buried 24 September 1964 in Grave T 2014.



14. **Howard Eric DUNCAN** born 9 December 1883 and baptised in 1885 by Holy Trinity Church. Howard, a shepherd, was married to **Georgina HALLIDAY** 25 March 1922 at Port Stephens, West Falkland by J Robertson JP, Deputy Registrar. The witnesses were David Henry Duncan and Emily Louisa Goodwin. Howard's father was recorded as William Duncan, deceased, and Georgina's father was recorded as John Halliday, shepherd. Georgina, age 59, died 18 January 1961 at Hill Cove and is buried there. Howard, age 80 and a handyman, died 10 October 1964 on West Falkland and was buried in Grave T 2016.
15. **Catherine Alice "Katie" DUNCAN** born 21 February 1885 on Beaver Island and baptised in 1885 by Holy Trinity Church. Catherine was married to **Alfred Walter Waldemar CHRIST**, mariner, 23 May 1928 on Beaver Island by Special Licence by S E E Aylward, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Ethel Mary McLeod and James Alexander Duncan. Alfred's father was recorded as Adolf Christ, doctor, and Catherine's father was recorded as William Duncan, shepherd. **Alfred Walker Wilmot CHRIST**, age 37 and a seaman from Denmark, died of heart disease on board the cutter *Weddell* at New Island 17 July 1929 and was buried on Beaver Island. Catherine, age 89 and a widow, died in Stanley 25 September 1974 and was buried in Grave U 1839.
16. **Ida Frances DUNCAN** born Wednesday 23 June 1886 (*per her father's diary; official records say 23 July 1886*) on Beaver Island and baptised 1 May 1887 by Holy Trinity Church. Ida was married to **Donald John McLEOD**, shepherd, 23 October 1917 at Beaver Island, West Falkland by Governor's Licence by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Howard Eric Duncan and Catherine Alice Duncan. Donald's father was recorded as Alexander McLeod, mariner, and Ida's father was recorded as William Duncan, deceased shepherd. Donald, age 64 and a publican from Scotland, died 18 February 1954 and was buried in Grave P 1531. Ida, age 76, died in Stanley 23 May 1963 and was buried in Grave P 1738.

Children of Margaret (3) DUNCAN:

1. **Boy DUNCAN** born 17 December 1887 and baptised **James Thomas CANN** in 1888 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's name was not recorded on his birth certificate. James departed 29 August 1929 on board the *Laguna* bound for Punta Arenas

Children of Margaret (3) and William CANN:

1. **Elizabeth Sarah Agnes CANN** born 10 July 1889 and baptised 15 November 1889 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as shipwright. Elizabeth was married to **Magnus Karl Frederick JACOBSEN**, a mariner from Denmark, 25 July 1916 at Christ Church Cathedral by Governor's Licencer by C McDonald Hobley. The witnesses were E J J Berntsen and John A Alazia. Magnus died, age 64, 7 September 1953 and is buried in Grave Q1518. Elizabeth died 25 March 1962 at Stanley and is buried in Grave Q1716.
2. **George William CANN** born 2 November 1890 and baptised **George William Thomas CANN** 14 November 1892 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter.
3. **Alfred Brewer CANN** born 26 June 1892 and baptised 14 November 1892 by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as carpenter. Alfred emigrated to Chile in 1922.

Children of Annie (4) and John MARKLAND:

1. **Mary Elizabeth MARKLAND** born 30 March 1888. Died 23 April 1902 of a chill and peritonitis and is buried at Port Stephens.
2. **William MARKLAND** born 23 August 1889. Family left for the UK 11 October 1904 on board the "Oruba".
3. **Frank Theodore MARKLAND** born 27 March 1891. Family left for the UK 11 October 1904 on board the "Oruba".
4. **George Alexander MARKLAND** born 19 August 1893. Family left for the UK 11 October 1904 on board the "Oruba".
5. **David Henry MARKLAND** born 14 February 1896. Family left for the UK 11 October 1904 on board the "Oruba".
6. **Agnes Maud MARKLAND** born 7 February 1901. Family left for the UK 11 October 1904 on board the "Oruba".
7. **Helen Dorothy MARKLAND** born 10 June 1904. Family left for the UK 11 October 1904 on board the "Oruba".

Children of Agnes (5) and William WILLIAMS:

1. **Douglas Charles Seccombe WILLIAMS** born 28 July 1892. His father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer. Douglas left Punta Arenas to fight at the Front May/June 1916. [FIM Jun 1916] Douglas is on the Cross of Sacrifice in the British cemetery at Punta Arenas.



2. **Stuart Duncan WILLIAMS** born 3 February 1896 and baptised 14 March 1897 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. His father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer. Stuart joined the Hampshire Carabineers in October 1913 as a trooper. Received a commission in the Household Battalion in February 1917. Reported missing at the Front 1916. [FIM Aug 1917; Mar 1918] Unofficially reported killed on 3 May 1917. [FIM Mar 1918] Stuart, age 21, a second lieutenant in the Household Battalion, died 3 May 1917 and is recorded on Bay 1 of the Arras Memorial. [CWG]
3. **Maxwell Henry WILLIAMS** born 14 March 1898 and baptised 26 April 1899 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. His father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer. Maxwell was educated at St Edmund's College, Ware, England. Maxwell enlisted in 1916 in the Artist's Rifles and gained his commission in May 1917. [FIM Sep 1916; Mar 1918] Maxwell, age 19, a second Lieutenant, was killed in action 19 September 1917. [FIM Mar 1918] Maxwell, a second

lieutenant in the London Regiment was buried in grave VG6 in Vlamertinghe New Military Cemetery. [CWG]

4. **Julia Agnes Augusta WILLIAMS** born 9 January 1908 and baptised 8 November 1908 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as sheep farmer. In 1917 Julia was of failing health and ordered by specialists to live at Nice. [FIM Aug 1917]

Children of Mary (6) and Farquhar MACRAE (MCRAE):

1. **John Macrae DUNCAN** born 20 October 1890 on Beaver Island. *NB: In birth registers it says that his mother is Agnes but Dolly Penguin states that Mary was his mother.* **Roderick Duncan McRAE**, foreman, was married to **Clara Eveline CULL** 30 July 1920 at New Island, West Falkland by Special Licence by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Duncan McRae and Ethel Mary Cull. Roderick's father was recorded as Farquhar McRae, deceased, and Clara's father was recorded as Robert Bertram Cull, deceased. Roderick was paid off from Spring Point in 1931 and went to work on Saunders Island. [FIC/EF/5] Roderick left Speedwell Island May 1943 to go to New Island on doctor's orders as the Island boat work was upsetting his health. Clara stayed cooking for the men at £3 a month until the end of May. [FIC/EF/] Roderick, age 68 and a garage assistant, died in Stanley 7 July 1959 and was buried 10 July 1959 in Grave S1636. Clara, age 63 and a widow, emigrated to the UK in 1959. She was recorded as being 5' 2" tall with hazel eyes and grey hair. Clara died in Scotland in 1980.
2. **Anabella Agnes "Bella" MCRAE** born 13 May 1892 on Beaver Island. Married **Evander MacLENNAN**, a shepherd 28 June 1919 at Weddell Island by Special Licence by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Duncan McRae and Rose Helen Hall. Family emigrated to the UK in 1927.
3. **Catherine Ellen "Nelly" MCRAE** born 26 September 1893. Died 8 March 1919 of double pneumonia and is buried on Weddell Island.
4. **Donald Alick MCRAE** born 29 September 1894. Married **Lily May SHORT** 2 September 1920 at Christ Church Cathedral by Special Licence by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Archie Short and Margaret Jane Short. Lily died 2 December 1949 and is buried in Grave L1418. Donald died 2 April 1959 and is buried in Grave L1628.
5. **Farquhar William Duncan "Duncan" MCRAE** born 8 May 1896. Labourer. Married (1) **Ellen Celice Wilhelmina MURPHY** 1 May 1935 at the Deputy Registrar's Office, Fox Bay by Registrar General's Licence by William B Myles, Deputy Registrar. The witnesses were Kathleen Edith Marguerite Jones and David John Murphy. Divorced 1940. Foreman. Married (2) **Gwenifer May JONES**, domestic, 16 October 1942 at Port Stephens, West Falklands by Banns by Charles H Robertson, Justice of Peace. The witnesses were Anne Robertson and J W Jones. Divorced 1959. Farquhar died 9 April 1967 at Weddell Island and is buried in Grave T2074.
6. **Rachel MCRAE** born 25 November 1897. Married **George Dederick HANSEN**, shepherd, 20 June 1916 at Weddell Island Station by Governor's Licence by C McDonald Hobley, Chaplain. The witnesses were Roderick D McRae and Duncan McRae. George died 28 June 1969 and is buried in Grave Q1784. Rachel died 5 May 1957 and is buried in Grave Q1586
7. **Boy MCRAE** born 1 June 1903. Died 13 hours after birth. Buried on Weddell Island.
8. **Stillborn boy MCRAE** born 5 September 1910.
9. **John James MCRAE** born 11 September 1912. Went to the UK with his mother in 1927.

Children of David (8) and Agnes DUNCAN:

1. **Agnes DUNCAN** born 11 October 1915 and baptised 27 April 1916 by Christ Church Cathedral. Married **William Charles ALAZIA**, a shepherd, 14 June 1939 at the Registrar's Office, Stanley by Special Licence by A R Hoare, Registrar General. The witnesses were David John Murphy and Violet Maud Hennah. Agnes died 5 June 1960 at Stanley and is buried in Grave Q1668. William died 21 August 1980 at Stanley and is buried in Grave U1957.
2. **David John DUNCAN** born 12 March 1916 at Port Stephens and baptised 27 April 1916 by Christ Church Cathedral. Married **Alice Florence DETTLEFF** 25 September 1942 at the Registrar's Office, Stanley by Special Licence by J E Hamilton, Registrar General. The witnesses were N Peck, Ellen Peck and James P Peck. They divorced 5 May 1955. David, age 62 and a farm worker, committed suicide at Roy Cove 21 September 1978 and was buried 26 September 1978 in Grave U1932. Alice, age 69 and a cleaner, died 25 June 1987 and was buried 10 July 1987 in Grave R3079.
3. **William DUNCAN** born 29 December 1918 at Port Stephens and baptised 6 July 1919 by Christ Church Cathedral. Married **Doreen "Rene" McCULLUM**, a domestic servant, 15 August 1947 at Christ Church Cathedral by R G R Calvert, Senior Chaplain. The witnesses were Elizabeth Ann McCullum and Dorothy Reive. William, age 82 and a pensioner, died in Stanley 25 July 2001 and was buried 31 July 2001 in Grave V3338. Doreen, age 83 and living at 5 Thatcher Drive, Stanley, died 4 May 2013 and was buried 9 May 2013 in Grave W3563.
4. **James Alexander DUNCAN** born 1 October 1920 at Port Stephens and baptised 2 February 1921 by Christ Church Cathedral. Married **Avis Marion BINNIE** 21 July 1945 at Chartres, West Falkland by K W Luxton, Justice of the Peace. The witnesses were Thomas George Aldridge and Flora Kathleen Stewart. James, age 68 and retired, died in Stanley 2 December 1988 and was buried 7 December 1988 in Grave V3102. Avis, age 71 and a widow living at 6 Pioneer Row, Stanley, died 18 December 1991 and was buried 23 December 1991 in Grave V3162.
5. **Helen DUNCAN** born 28 October 1926 at Carew Harbour and baptised 20 January 1929 by Christ Church Cathedral. Married (1) **Edward Thomas Crawford DICKSON**, a shepherd, 2 December 1944 at Port Stephens by Charles H Robertson, Justice of Peace. The witnesses were William Blyth Berntsen and Linda Kivell. They divorced 17 January 1956. Married (2) **Richard Louis ANDERSON** 21 January 1956 at the Office of the Registrar General, Stanley by Harold Bennett, Registrar General. The witnesses were William Charles Alazia and Agnes Alazia. Helen died 12 March 2004.
6. **Howard Henry DUNCAN** born [REDACTED]. Married (1) **Eveline Bertha THOMPSON** née **McRAE**, divorcee, 11 January 1956 at the Office of the Registrar General, Stanley by Harold Bennett, Registrar General. The witnesses were W Duncan and Doreen Duncan. The marriage was dissolved. Married (2) **Christina MacLean**, a careworker from Scotland, 23 August 1997 at the Malvina House Hotel, Stanley by Special Licence by J C Rowland, Registrar General. The witnesses were S Halford and R J Halford.

Children of Helen (9) DUNCAN:

1. **Lionel DUNCAN** born 26 December 1900 and baptised 18 April 1901 by Christ Church Cathedral. Not in birth records. Left with his mother and her husband James Greig 1903.

Children of Elizabeth (10) DUNCAN:

1. **Annie Agnes DUNCAN** born 2 January 1903 at Pouvenir, Tierra del Fuego, and baptised 24 February 1904 in Patagonia.

Children of Elizabeth (10) and Angus McLEOD:

1. **Isabella Catherine McLEOD** born 12 February 1905 (*Punta Arenas?*). Baptised 1 March 1905, family living in Punta Arenas.
2. **Ethel Mary McLEOD** born 29 April 1906 in Tierra del Fuego. Baptised 24 October 1906, family living in Secunda, Argentina. Married **Frederick Stanley DAVIS** 19 July 1934 at the Registrar's Office, Stanley by Special Licence by A R Hoare, Ag Registrar General. Witnesses R Davis and Agnes B Butcher. Frederick died prior to 1955. Ethel emigrated to UK in 1955.
3. **Lucy Janet McLEOD** born 19 November 1907 (*Patagonia?*). Baptised 28 January 1908, family living at Gente Grande.
4. **Agnes McLEOD** born 10 May 1911 (*Punta Arenas?*). Baptised 16 November 1913, family living in Punta Arenas.
5. **Margaret McLEOD** born 11 June 1913 (*Punta Arenas?*). Baptised 16 November 1913, family living in Punta Arenas.
6. **Kathleen McLEOD** born 13 December 1915 at 11pm (twin), West Falkland. Baptised in Stanley 3 May 1915.
7. **John McLEOD** born 14 December 1915 at 12am (twin), West Falkland. Baptised Stanley 3 May 1915.

Children of Rachel (12) and George STEWART:

1. **Boy STEWART** born 14 July 1905 in Moose Jaw, North West Territories, Canada.

Children of Howard (14) and Georgina DUNCAN:

1. **Peter Reid Howard DUNCAN** born 23 September 1930 and baptised 12 October 1930 by Christ Church Cathedral. Peter died 26 December 2005 and was buried in Grave W3415.
2. **George Stewart DUNCAN** born [REDACTED]. Seaman.

Children of Ida (16) and Donald McLEOD:

1. **Agnes Kathleen McLEOD** born 28 February 1918. Agnes was married to **Henry Leslie WHITNEY**, labourer, 31 July 1940 at the Registrar's Office, Stanley by Special Licence by A R Hoare, Registrar General. The witnesses were David John Duncan and Alice Florence Dettleff. Henry's father was recorded as George Eddy Whitney, labourer, and Agnes' father was recorded as Donald John McLeod labourer.
