

GRANT FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Various spellings of names are recorded as written at the time.

Hugh GRANT was born circa 1858? (*not in Falkland Islands*).

In 1882 Hugh was working as a shepherd in the new settlement at Hill Cove. [Falklands Heritage, Mary Trehearne]

Hugh, age 27 and a shepherd at Chartres River, was married to **Margaret ROSS**, age 33 and a domestic servant at Fox Bay 13 December 1885 at Fox Bay according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church by Waite H Falkland Islands. The witnesses were William Ross and A J Anderson, MD CM. Hugh's father was recorded as Donald Grant, labourer, and Margaret's father was recorded as Roderick Ross, crofter.

Hugh, Margaret and their three children departed 13 March 1893 on board the *Tanis* which as bound for Montevideo.

Hugh arrived 14 October 1893 on board the *Totmes* from Europe.

Margaret and her three children arrived 29 August 1896 on the *Luxor* from London.

Margaret and her three children arrived 8 September 1900 on board the *Chance* from Main Point. They departed 26 September 1900 on board the *Lusitania* which was bound for England.

Hugh arrived 30 March 1903 on the *Hornet* from San Carlos and Kelp Harbour. Hugh departed 1 April 1903 on board the *Oravia* bound for Liverpool

FIRST GENERATION

Children of Hugh and Margaret GRANT:

1. **James Hugh GRANT** born 1 March 1887 and baptised 11 May 1887 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as shepherd.
2. **William Taylor GRANT** born 25 August 1888 and baptised 28 October 1888 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation wasn't recorded.
3. **Anne Sophia Malvina GRANT** born 22 November 1891 at Hill Cove and baptised 6 April 1892 by Holy Trinity Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as shepherd.
