

HENDRICKSEN FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.

Berndt Heider HENDRICKSEN was born circa 1854 (*not in the Falkland Islands*).

Berndt, age 24 and a sailor living on Carcass Island, was married to **Maria Katrina HANSEN**, age 19 and living on Carcass Island, 7 September 1878 in the Parish Church according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the Established Church after Banns by Lowther E Brandon MA Colonial Chaplain. The witnesses were Charles Hansen and Emma Bartlett. Berndt's father was recorded as Henry Hansen Henricksen, provision dealer, and Maria's father was recorded as Peter Frederick Hansen, farmer.

On 17 August 1881 Berndt, seaman and occupier of the house in Stanley, was the informant of the death of Charles GODFREY.

FIRST GENERATION:

Children of Berndt and Maria HENDRICKSEN (1):

1. **John Hendrick HENDRICKSON** born 9 July 1879 on Carcass Island and baptised **John Henry HENDRICKSON** 20 July 1879 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as seaman.
2. **Wilhelm Marcus HENDRICKSEN** born 23 March 1883 in Stanley and baptised 10 June 1883 by Holy Trinity Church. His father's occupation was recorded as seaman.
