

McMULLEN FAMILY

NB: The following is prepared from Falkland Islands Registers and files – there may be other family born outside the Falklands. Unless stated otherwise, all dated births, deaths and marriages occurred in the Falklands and all numbered graves are in Stanley Cemetery. Any variations which may occur in the spellings of names are recorded as written in the records at the time.

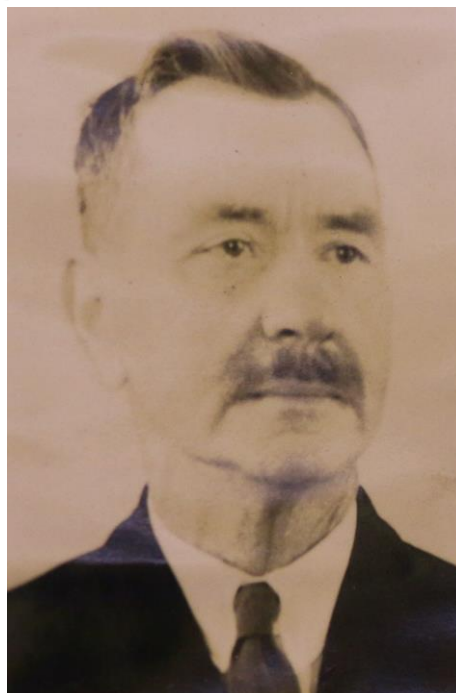
David McMULLEN was born 18 December 1836 in Wigton, Cumbria, England to **Henry McMULLEN** and **Anne McMULLEN** née **MAJOR**. David was married to **Margaret JEFFERS** 27 December 1857 in Sunderland, Durham, England. David, age 66, died 22 March 1903 in San Julian, Santa Cruz, Argentina.

Children of David and Margaret MCMULLEN:

1. **John Henry McMULLEN** born 11 January 1859 in Sunderland, England. John died 10 February 1860 in Sunderland.
2. **Ann McMULLEN** born 13 May 1861 in Sunderland, England. Ann died 20 August 1862 in Sunderland.
3. **Edward Henry McMULLEN** born 18 June 1863 in Sunderland, England. Edward, age 42, died 17 June 1906 in Buenos Aires, Argentina.
4. **James McMULLEN** born 31 January 1866 in Buenos Aires, Argentina.
5. **Matthew Jeffers McMULLEN** born 15 August 1868 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Matthew started work for the Falkland Islands Company Limited 4 October 1901 as a navy at North arm on a salary of £5 a month. From 1 January 1903 he was working as a shepherd at North Arm. From 1 January 1920 Matthew worked as part of the jetty gang in Stanley. From 20 May 1923 he worked as a store carrier, packing assistant, etc and worked in this position until 2 April 1932. [FIC/IC2 #7-Mc33: FIC/IW7: FIC/IW8] Mathew, a British shepherd, was married to **Marion HEWITT** 6 August 1908 at the Registrar's Office, Darwin by C N Foley, JP & Registrar of Marriages. The witnesses were Frederick John Biggs and Phoebe Jane Mary Elizabeth Biggs. Mathew's father was recorded as David McMullen, dead, and Marion's father was recorded as Donald Hewitt, shepherd. Matthew was paid a pension of £45 from the Falkland Islands Co Ltd commencing from the termination of his employment on Firday 29 July 1932 and paid on the last day of each quarter. [FIC/EF/5] Matthew, age 71 and a cook, died 16 December 1939 and was buried in Grave N1150. Marian, age 61 and a widow, died 15 September 1949 and was buried 17 September 1949 in Grave M1408.



6. **John Major McMULLEN** born 13 September 1871 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. John, age 31, died 21 August 1903 in San Julian, Santa Cruz, Argentina.
7. **Francis Timothy McMULLEN** born 31 January 1873 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Francis, age 54, died 20 March 1927 in San Julian, Santa Cruz, Argentina.
8. **Ann McMULLEN** born 27 September 1875 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Ann was married to **Tomas DENHOLM** (*not in the Falkland Islands*). Ann, age 96, died 20 October 1971 in San Julian, Santa Cruz, Argentina.
9. **Elizabeth McMULLEN** born 11 July 1878 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Elizabeth died in San Julian, Santa Cruz, Argentina.
10. **Susan McMULLEN** born 13 December 1879 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Susan died in San Julian, Santa Cruz, Argentina.
11. **David McMULLEN** born December 1881. David, a shepherd, was married to **Margaret Ann ADAM** 15 November 1916 at Christ Church Cathedral by Banns by J Stanley Smith, Clerk in Holy Orders. The witnesses were Ernest Dixon and Margaret McLeod. David's father was recorded as David McMullen, deceased shoemaker, and Margaret's father was recorded as James Adam, deceased carpenter. David died in Rio Gallegos, Argentina. David and Margaret spent their honeymoon in Punta Arenas. [FIM Dec 1916]
12. **William McMULLEN** born 27 August 1888 at Mar del Plata, Argentina. William worked for the Falkland Islands Company Ltd in the Lafonia area from 14 March 1913 to 2 April 1913 on a salary of £5 a month. [FIC/IW8] William, age 50 and a single shepherd, went to Chile and Argentina on business in 1938. He was recorded as being 5' 8" tall with brown eyes and brown hair. William, a labourer, was married to **Ann Fraser HOLLEN**, domestic servant, 9 June 1951 at the United Free Church (Tabernacle), Stanley by Walter Forrest McWhan, Minister. The witnesses were William John Smith and Hannah Caroline Smith. William's father was recorded as David McMullen, deceased farmer, and Ann's father was recorded as Henry Billington Hollen, deceased shepherd. William, age 71 and a labourer from Argentina, died in Stanley 23 May 1956 and was buried 26 May 1956 in Grave S1573.

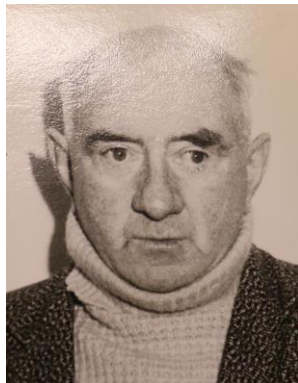


William in 1938

FIRST GENERATION

Children of Mathew and Marion McMULLEN:

1. **David James Edward Henry McMULLEN** born 11 June 1909 at North Arm and baptised 4 September 1909 at North Arm by Christ Church Cathedral. His father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. David was baptised 1 December 1909 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. David, a shepherd, was married to **Maggie Ann MACKAY** 2 13 July 1938 at San Carlos Station, East Falkland by Registrar General's Licence by John Francis Bonner, Ag Registrar. The witnesses were J R Mackay and F C Betts. David's father was recorded as Mathew McMullen, cook, and Maggie's father was recorded as James R Mackay, handyman. David and Maggie divorced in 1967. David, age 63 and a single farm manager, went to the Argentine on holiday in 1972. He was recorded as being 5' 8" tall with grey eyes. David, age 65 and an overseer on Lively Island, shot himself on Lively Island 10 September 1974 and was buried 12 September 1974 in Grave U1837.

2. **William John Andrew Francis McMULLEN** born 8 December 1911 in Lafonia and baptised 15 December 1919 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. His father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. William, age 17, died 4 January 1929 from concussion from a fracture at the base of his skull, cerebral thrombosis of convulsion and was buried in Grave N990.
3. **Mathew Jeffers McMULLEN** born 17 April 1914 in Central Camp, North Arm and baptised 15 December 1919 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. His father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. Mathew, a handyman mechanic with PWD, resigned 24 October 1962. Mathew, age 56 and a lighthouse keeper, went to South America for medical treatment in 1971. He was recorded as being 5' 10" tall with grey eyes and dark brown hair.

4. **Edith Margaret Wilhelmina McMULLEN** born 13 July 1916 at North Arm and baptised 15 December 1919 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as shepherd. Edith, age 26 and in service, went to Montevideo on holiday in 1944. She was recorded as being 5' 1 ½ " tall with grey/green eyes and brown hair. Edith, age 55 and an R/T operator, emigrated to the UK in 1972.

5. **Joy Sara Lucy McMULLEN** born 30 December 1924 and baptised 18 January 1925 by St Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Her father's occupation was recorded as store assistant. Joy, age 19 and a domestic servant, went to Montevideo on holiday in 1944. She was recorded as being 5' 2" tall with brown eyes and brown hair. Joy was married to **James William Thomas LEE**, shepherd, 1 August 1946 at the Nonconformist Church (Tabernacle), Stanley by Walter Forrest McWhan, Nonconformist Minister. The witnesses were Frederick Francis Lee and Edith McMullen. James' father was recorded as Edward Thomas Lee, shepherd boss, and Joy's father was recorded as Mathew Jeffers McMullen, deceased. James, age 43 and a sheep farmer, Joy and their daughter Penelope, went on holiday to the UK in 1956.
