Sir, I have the honor to inform Your Excellency that I have this day notified Candido Martinez and Carmelo Rodriguez, two persons who have terminated their engagements in the Company's service that they may have free passage in the Company's Schooner to Montevideo, to leave here about the 21st instant, and that if they do not leave thereby I shall report their refusal to Your Excellency in order that such measures as may seem fit may be taken to secure the Company from future responsibility in their regard under the Alien Ordinance.
