Dollars per week - When I've nothing  
else to do, I get stuff from Murray  
and make up things to sell. I  
buy it and make up things to  
sell for myself. Larry and Linn  
have bought shirts and trousers that  
I have made. It costs me about  
25¢ for Mr to live - I pay my house  
rent. I'm not allowed to give persons  
a night's lodging because the house  
belongs to Rollon. but I have visitors  
occasionally in the day. There's no  
card playing in my house. Baker  
left his coat yesterday in my house  
and a bag, and in the evening  
fetched it again.

I am working for Ennis.  
Mr. Williams brought me to Stanley  
under a contract with Mr. Lafone.  
I get a dollar per day when I work.  
it costs me about a dollar per week  
to live.

Luis Pascual.

Leon Marcelini brought me here  
under a contract with Mr. Lafone.  
I have not been to work for the  
last 2 months. Since I was turned  
off the Govt. Works. for a livelihood  
I have cut peat and now sell it  
to any person who wishes to buy it.  
It costs me for living from  $\frac{4}{10}$  to  $\frac{8}{10}$   
per week. I have been in the Falls-  
lands about 7 years. I have been  
5 years in Stanley. As soon as Bonner  
comes in, I am going to Hope Place.

George Green.

It costs me 3 dollars per week  
to live. I am shoe-making. I make

16 Scollars for Weets at my trade.

Phillip Carravalla.

I am working for no person at present. I am going to Hope Place shortly. I have lately been working for the Company. I was brought here by Mr. Williams.

times and then I buy some beef.

Carlos Tivallo - Ex<sup>o</sup> by W. L. Taylor  
25<sup>th</sup> May 1855.

I came 4 years ago in the *Proantimo*,  
brought by Mr Williams - for  
whom I worked 2 years. Landed  
at Hope Place. - I have no money.

Felipe Caravallo. -

I came in 1847 in the *Probleon* -  
landed at Port Louis - I worked for  
Mr Williams six years - and been  
in Stanley without work, 4 months.  
Has \$100 - has an order for a passage  
transferred to him by Gonzalez Pradest

Titusio Sere.

I came here in the *Vigilante* - to  
Port Louis - to work for Mr Williams  
in 1848. Worked for Mr Williams about  
22 mo<sup>s</sup>, then came to Stanley -  
returned & stopped 12 years - came  
back to settlement & subsequently  
returned, has been 6 months in  
the settlement. Has an order for
