Sir,

Craving reference to my letter of the 2.<sup>nd</sup> instant I beg to acquaint you that the woman Soyla Franco to depart pursuant to notice upon the 19.<sup>th</sup> instant will only take with her three children in lieu of four.

The boy Regustiano remains behind by the mother's consent in charge of its Godfather Jose Maria Arquello and I undertake that it is under the Company's responsibility here in the same manner as if it had been brought here by Arquello as his own.
