Sir,

I have the honour to submit herewith my report on the Census of the inhabitants of this Colony, which was taken on the 18th March, 1962.

2. The total population on Census day was 2,172, of whom 1,195 were males and 977 females. The comparative figures for the 1953 Census were 2,230, 1,246, and 984 respectively.

3. On the 18th March, 1962, Ellen McAskill aged 92 years, of Stanley, was the oldest female in the Colony and Frederick George Lee aged 90 years, of Stanley, was the oldest male.

4. I would like to express my grateful thanks to the Enumerators Mr. J. D. Williams and Mr. D. H. McMillan of the Police and Prisons Department for the very conscientious and efficient manner in which they carried out their onerous duties.

Finally I would record my appreciation of the assistance given by Mr. D. Desborough in analysing the data from the Schedules.

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Colony of the Falkland Islands - (Excluding the Dependencies)

Report of Census taken on the 18th March, 1962.

Growth of the Population — Table I.

1. The population figures given for the years 1851, 1861 and 1871 are estimated, while those given for the years 1881 onwards are taken from the respective Census reports.

2. During the years 1911 to 1962 the population fluctuated between 2,272 and 2,172. The population declined to 2,094 in 1921 just before a peak of 2,392 was recorded by the 1931 census.

Distribution of Population by Age Groups and Sexes — Tables II & IIA.

3. During the past nine years the total population decreased from 2,230 by 58 persons (51 males and 7 females) to 2,172. The population of Stanley decreased by 61 (37 males and 24 females) from 1,135 to 1,074, and that of the East Falkland showed a net decrease of 45 (decrease of 50 males and an increase of 5 females) from 642 to 597 while that of the West Falkland increased by 7 (decrease of 2 males and an increase of 9 females) from 453 to 460.

4. Table IIA shows the percentage under certain age groups as compared with the 1953 census.

Marital Status according to Age Groups — Tables III & IIIA.

5. Table III discloses little change in comparison with the previous census.

6. Table IIIA shows comparative percentages of the marital status of the population in 1953 and 1962.

Births and Birth Rates during the period 1953-1961 — Table IV.

7. This is a new table which shows the number of children of each sex registered as being born during the period 1953-1961 to parents normally resident in the Colony. The birth rate per thousand is based on the population figures published annually in the Gazette.

Deaths and Death Rates during the period 1953-1961 — Table V.

8. Table V is a new table and shows the number of registered deaths among persons of each sex forming part of the normally resident population during 1953-1961. The death rate per thousand is based on the figures published annually by the Registrar General.

Birthplace of Population — Table VI.

9. It is interesting to note that the local born population is steadily declining while the number of resident persons born in the United Kingdom has gradually increased since the 1946 Census. The Census of 1946 showed that 2,001 persons were born in the Falkland Islands and 164 in the United Kingdom. The figures for 1953 and 1962 were 1,863 and 306 and 1,733 and 338 respectively.

Nationalities — Table VII.

10. It will be seen from Table VII that 2,136 of the population or 98.34% are British Subjects and the remaining 36 or 1.66% are divided among 9 nationalities.

Distribution of Population by Occupation — Table VIII, A, B, & C.

11. These tables are divided to show the occupation of females as well as males.

12. Classification has been determined by work performed and not by occupational nomenclature.

Religious distribution of Population — Table IX.

13. The religions of the population are shown at Table IX which indicates that the Falkland Islands continues to be a predominantly Anglican community.

14. In 1953 there were 1,425 Anglicans in the Colony or 63.9% of the population. In 1962 there were 1,406 or 64.73% of the population. The non-conformists remain very much approximate at 498 while the Roman Catholics remain static at 236.

Housing — Table X.

15. This gives details relating to the distribution of population according to living room units and includes information relating to occupied and unoccupied houses, water supply, sanitation, baths and the birthplace of the head of each household.

Natural growth of the Population — Table XI.

16. The average number of births registered during the past nine years (1953-1961) was 46 while the average number of deaths registered over the same period was 24, thus showing an average increase in the population of 22.

Immigration and Emigration — Table XII.

17. The data shown in this table did not result from the Census, but is included in this report because of its relevance when considering population trends.

18. During the past nine years (1953-1961) immigrants averaged 241 and emigrants 280, showing an annual exodus of 39 persons during that period, compared with 11 during the preceding 7 years.

Births and Deaths, 1853-1961 — Table XIII.

19. This Table is included in this report for the purpose of recording the births and deaths registered during the period 1853-1961.
