

This Deed made the Twenty Fifth
day of January in the year of our Lord
one Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Nine
Between Christopher Murry of Stanley
in the County of Ross of the one Part
and James Philipps of Stanley in said
County of the other part. Whereas Thomas
Hearnden by grant from the Crown bearing date
the third day of October one Thousand Eight
Hundred and Forty Four was possessed of
the Town Lot Number Ten on the Grand
Map of the Town of Stanley in the Surveyors
Office to hold to him and his Assigns for
Ever. And Whereas The said Thomas
Hearnden by Deed of the First day of May
one Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Eight
Conveyed a part thereof in consideration
of Twenty Pounds Sterling to Christopher
Murry aforesaid described in said Deed of
the First day of May one thousand Eight
Hundred and Forty Eight as All that Portion
of said Town Lot Number Ten Containing
in front to the Holding of John Herkes Thirty
Three feet in the Rear to the holding of
Thomas Sully the like number of Thirty Three
feet and in depth from front to rear on the
East and West sides respectively Ninety Nine
feet Bounded on the North by the holding
of John Herkes on the South by the holding of
Thomas Sully on the East by Town Lot
Number Eleven and on the West by the
holding of Alexander McIntosh to hold
to the said Christopher Murry his Heirs and
Assigns
