I send you the order of proceedings in the induction of the Archdeacon.
I think it would be a good thing to commence Cathedral Archives.
You could begin with these.

- 1st The taking of the Oath of Canonical Obedience
and the Declaration of Assent before me.
- 2nd The Reading and Presentation of my Appointment
to be Archdeacon of Stanley.
- 3rd The reading of the Mandate to the Dean to instal
him in the Cathedral.
- 4th Canon Walker then read your general licence for
him to be installed in St. Paul's Valparaiso with
the same effect as in the Cathedral.
Canon Walker as an Hon Canon declares himself
competent to act.
- 5th The Oath to uphold the Cathedral is taken before
Walker who leads the Archdeacon to the Sanctuary
and places him in a chair, with the Collect to
close.

I also enclose something to be read to the people as near Easter as is
possible. Remember me to the Governor and Mrs Beattie and Ian.

I, FREDERICK SALMON VAUGHAN, clerk, Fean of the Cathedral Church of Christ Church, Port Stanley, Falkland Islands, do hereby issue a general authority to Induct and Inatall the Archdeacon of Stanley and the Honorary Canons in the Church of St. Paul Valparaiso, Chile, with the same effect as in the Cathedral itself.

I do also empower the Archdeacon or one of the Honorary Canons to act as my Representative in this respect.

Provided always that an oath be taken to maintain the dignity and rights of the Cathedral Church.

I, Philip James Reeves Walker, Honorary Canon of Christ Church Cathedral, Stanley, am hereby authorised to Install George Ruthven Thornton as Archdeacon of Stanley.

MANDATE for INSTALLATION.

We, NORMAN STEWART by Divine Permission LORD BISHOP of the FALKLAND ISLANDS and in WESTERN SOUTH AMERICA: having appointed our Well-Beloved in CHRIST the Rev. GEORGE RUTHVEN THORNTON Master of Arts to be ARCHDEACON of STANLEY, do hereby call upon and require the Very Reverend FREDERICK SALMON VAUGHAN, Dean of CHRIST CHURCH CATHEDRAL, PORT STANLEY, to RECEIVE, ADMIT; and INSTAL the said ARCHDEACON OF STANLEY to a stall to be assigned to him in our Cathedral.

We do further WILL and ENJOIN upon all whom it may concern that the Archdeacon of Stanley now and during his tenure of the Office holds the Second place in the Cathedral Chapter.

In Testimony whereof we have set our hand hercunto and caused our Episcopal Seal to be affixed to these presents.

Oath to be taken by Archdeacon.
