Amol Sec. I have discussed with Mr Roberts  
the question of a site for the proposed Government  
Building and we have agreed that subject to  
your approval the most suitable would be  
north of the Town Hall & Public Baths, if this  
site is approved it will be necessary to  
purchase cable for Broadcast & Telephone work  
at an approximate cost of £65, it would be also  
necessary to add cost of electrical material  
for at least 15 lights and power points and  
underground cable to supply same, this cost  
would be in the region of £30 plus £10 for  
labour charges, making a total expenditure  
for the Electrical Department of approximately  
£105. I respectfully ask that this sum should  
be allowed in addition to the £1,000 estimated  
for floor space of 889 sq ft to serve as C. Office  
Telegraph, Studios, Store & workshop
