No. 37. Circular. Most Secret.

A secret Broadcasting Station transmitting in German and known as " Deutscher Kurzwellsender Atlantik " will henceforth operate under the auspices of the Admiralty on 49 and 31 metres band at half hourly intervals from 15.30 hours to 06.00 hours G.M.T. It is being pointed out to the United Kingdom Press and Agencies that for Security reasons it is most important that they should not repeat not monitor this service or comment upon it. It would be appreciated if the Local Press could be asked to observe similar reticence in the event of these broadcasts being audible in your Territory. Chief Censor should also be warned and asked to delete any reference to the new station found in the mail.
