OUR Display was held on Friday, June 29th, in the Parish Hall, which had been decorated for the occasion. At one end of the hall sewing, embroidery, basketwork and other work completed by the girls during the last twelve months was on display, and the guests were shown around by the girls. The actual programme, which lasted for an hour and a half, consisted of drill by different squads of girls (including one of recruits who had joined during the last six weeks), country dancing by nearly all members, Home Nursing by Seniors and Pioneers, and First Aid by Juniors and Seniors. Refreshments, which were provided by the older girls, were served during the evening. Some seventy people attended, including His Excellency the Governor, and the Captain and Officers of The Boys' Brigade. Unfortunately our Chaplain could not be present, as he was on a tour of Camp stations.

The entire Company was grateful to His Excellency, who informed our Captain that he intended to present a silver cup to the Company to be competed for annually by the two platoons.
