

Sir,

With reference to your minute of the 24th of January, I am directed by the Governor to inform you that His Excellency is prepared to authorize an increase of £10 in the annual grant to the Public Library and Huseum provided that the Committee is able to make acceptable arrangements for supplying books from present stocks to form a nucleus of a library on the West Falkland Island. The value of the books supplies should be not less than £10 and pay ent of the latter sum will be made separate and apart from the increase in the grant when the supply of books has been effected.
