I beg to enclose tender, but with this work it is really impossible to be decisive, some of the birds are not in the best condition, but cannot finally say if they can be mounted until they are relaxed; for museum specimens it is usually agreed that if a skin will not mount well it should be remade into a skin and a better specimen supplied for mounting.

Every case shall be taken with the specimens, but should any of the skins prove to be tainted owing to lack of preserving in the first instance it would be unwise to attempt to make them into type museum specimens.

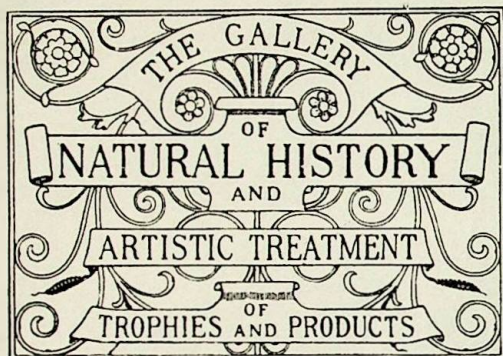
