In December 1914, Mr. Allardyce handed over to the Committee of the Falklands Museum a Collection of pictures of Ant Arctic Explorers, but suggested that they be kept at Government House until the new Museum was opened. Mr. Allardyce published a letter in the Falkland Is. Church paper in the same month announcing the gift of the pictures in question.

2. Now that the public Museum has been opened perhaps H.E. the Governor will allow the pictures to be placed either in the Museum or in the Public Library.
