

- 2. Councillors are dissatisfied because none of the last grant from the British Council has been allocated to the Public Library when half of the population resides in Stanley. They appreciate that more new books should be bought from Council funds (to encourage the Public to patronize the Library) but, without books from the British Council, the approximate value of that grant would have to be added to Council expenditure. Without purchasing any new books in 1960, the expenditure exceeded the revenue by £117.11s. 2d.
- 3. At a meeting of the Library Committee, Miss Biggs pointed out that:-

(a) she was not approached by Mr. Draycott after his

writing Minute No. 75 in file 0147;

(b) the last books from the British Council were received

by her in January, 1960;

(c) the Camp Library service operated by the Public Library has been in force for many years and Camp people are well aware of that fact;

(d) interest in the service diminished when the Falkland Islands Company started a service of supplying newer books, as the Town Council stipulation was that books must be in the Library for a year before being sent to the Camp;

(e) no postage is charged on books sent to or from the

Camp, that was arranged with Government;

(f) the books from the British Council have always been selected by her, as, having been Librarian for many years, she knows the kind of books that appeal to the General Public: and

- (g) since the School Library scheme started, children's subscriptions have dropped considerably and she feels that it will be the same with an adult section operating in opposition to the Public Library.
- 4. If Government considers that the Camp Library service should be operated by the Information Officer, Council suggests that:-

(i) half of the books be allocated to the Public Library as they arrive, then exchanged with the remainder after a certain period; and

(ii) if possible, books to be selected by the Librarian

as in the past.

5. It is the considered opinion of this Council that the British Council cannot be expected to make a further grant for the Public Library.

- (b) thereafter issues should be split on a 50% basis.

In regard to (a) I will do my best to get a list of books available so that the Town Council may make a choice of books most favourable to them; in regard to (b) when 50 50 split is made this should be by mutual arrangement between the Town Council Librarian on one hand and the Superintendent of Education on the other hand.

I appreciate that this must be referred to the Library Committee of the Stanley Council and I shall be obliged if you will let me have their agreement as soon as possible.

Dear Sir/s,

Over the years many papers of local interest have been written, some of which lie gathering dust in the archives whilst others repose on library shelves. New papers and articles also appear from time to time, and overall a considerable amount of biological, geographical, geological, historical, and political material, all of it very readable, is available for publication.

The cost of producing a booklet twice a year, and with a fairly limited circulation is, of course, high, and the object of this circular letter is to ask whether you would guarantee to take four or more copies of each issue for the first two issues, at an approximate price of five shillings or seven shillings and sixpence per copy. A larger guarantee would of course be very welcome.

If a guarantee of £150 can be obtained it should be possible to publish a magazine type booklet of about 60 pages, similar in format to the well known "Countryman" magazine.

You too might have something to offer: the Churches have yet to be approached: the Company will no doubt help with material. At a rough guess there is sufficient historical material to last for several years, and modern articles on grasses and grasslands, and wildlife, may surely be obtained.

If funds can be found to produce a booklet cum magazine of the type outlined above, circulation could extend to University and other libraries throughout the world.

Will you support the idea and will you guarantee something towards the first two issues at least?



Dear Sir,

Your kind offer to send magazines to the Falkland Islanders has been referred to me, and may I say how very touched we are. We certainly have no excess of interesting printed matter, and the magazines you mentioned will find excellent use, I assure you.

Mail comes to us from the mainland roughly once a month. It is useful to include "South Atlantic" in the address, as there are still people who think the Falkland Islands are somewhere off the coast of Scotland. The safest routing is via the G.P.O., London, but for some reason American post offices are reluctant to direct mail this way, and if they cannot be convinced that this is preferable (which is sometimes the case), the alternative route is via Montevideo, Uruguay - the mainland port from which boats depart for the Falklands. There is a risk that mail simply addressed to the Falkland Islands will be directed via Argentina, and this is disastrous, since Argentina claims sovereignty over the Falklands and mail from there is usually considerably delayed.

Once again, let me assure you of our gratitude that, in this world full of eruptions and countercruptions, you should think of this tiny, and largely neglected colony in the southern reaches of the Atlantic.
