EXTRACT FROM LETTER FROM TOWN CLERK TO HON. COL. SEC. OF 13.11.61.

A number of glass show-cases, once used for exhibits in the Museum, are stored in the Gymnasium. Council cannot visualise usage for them and would like to dispose of them but believe Government approval should first be obtained. Your guidance on this last matter, Sir, would be appreciated.

A/C is requesting a reply to I in order that it may be further discussed at the monthly meeting of Council on Monday.

I find on enquiry that a total of £800 was voted under Extraordinary Expenditure in 1952/53 for the provision of display cases for the museum. Two large wall cases were purchased thro' c/o at a total landed cost of £433.13.8 & a number of smaller cases (some or all mounted on tables) were constructed locally. There is no direct record of the cost of this work but it is known that the total expenditure under the vote amounted to £491.10.-. Thus if we deduct the cost of the two large cases from this it is reasonable to assume that the smaller cases cost £57.16.4.

Record O/C PWD has since phoned to say that there is a record at his Office which shows that £92.10.- was spent on the locally constructed cases - 6 in all.

Madam,

I am directed to refer to your letter of the 13th November, regarding the disposal of glass display cases at present housed in the Gymnasium and to say that the two large cases were originally purchased in 1952/53 for £433 and that the six smaller ones were constructed locally at a cost of £92 10s Od. Since the expenditure was met from public funds provided under head Extraordinary Expenditure of the 1952/53 Estimates it is considered that ownership of the cases should be retained by Government.
