Sir

We the undersigned most respectfully
implore Her Majesty's Government will be
pleased to change us from this to some genial
climate as we find by experience that we
cannot support our families here by our Agri-
cultural labour and as old Soldiers and
Pensioners we look to Her Majesty's Govern-
ment the same as children to their parents
and most respectfully implore that Her
Majesty's Government will be pleased to
look to our families, as it is not in our power
to make any provision for them in this place
for all we have to depend on is our days
labour which is scarcely sufficient to keep
us as provisions are generally dear here; and
we beg most respectfully to state that we
are thankful to H. S. the Governor for keeping

us employed, for there are no others here who can give us constant employment and we further beg to state with the greatest respect that we are willing and will be thankful to be changed to New Zealand - New Australia or Van Dieman's Land if Her Majesty's Government be pleased, and we will ever pray
