

Malvina Cottage. Stanley 14th July 1857.

Sir,

In compliance with your Excellency's desire that I should inform you in what manner I design to provide for the support of the three younger children of my Adorably deceased, who by her will constituted me their guardian; I beg to acquaint Your Excellency that I am about to send them to Montevideo by the packet, whence they will be conveyed, under charge of James Murray, to the care of the Rev. Anthony D. Fahey, Pastor of the Irish Catholics in Buenos Ayres - the Girl to be placed by that Gentleman in the Establishment conducted by the Sisters of Charity presided over by Miss Whable and the Boys in an Irish Industrial School under the Superintendance of Mr. Fahey. The children have a stock of sufficient clothing provided; I shall pay £10 in with the girl, and such sum as maybe needed by the rules for the boys, and I have every reason to believe that by this course they will be comfortably provided for until they can earn their living & after that superintended until of mature years.
