

In answer to your request item (10) Stanley Jetties.

(a) Of the 34 load bearing piles 28 are a complete write off.
All beams, bearers and decking are also wrotted and unserviceable.

To partially demolish would only leave the remaining part at the mercy of the tides which would soon become a hazard to small boats in the harbour.

To demolish all of it would cost somewhere in the region of 2100.

(b) In view of the jetty's condition described above, repair is not a practical proposition.
