S/S Confidential despatch of 25th August 1916 allowing the Ocean Co. a third whaler for seasons 1916-17; 1917-18; 1918-19: - usual fee to be paid for this extra licence.

Special conditions:

(a) The Company to ship to their Sth Georgia Station additional boilers of capacity not less than equivalent to 18 boilers 6ft in diameter by 8ft. in height, at least 12 being pressure boilers.

(b) The Company to provide a sailing vessel once in each of the three seasons (16-17, 17-18, 18-19) to call at Tristan da Cunha with mails & stores.
