
I am directed by the Governor to inform you, with reference to Mr Concell's minute No 418/16 of the 5th April, 1916, that in future Interior Reports on the Whaling Industry of South Georgia should be made half-yearly (for the half year ended 30th June, and 31st December each year) instead of quarterly as hitherto. The report to the 31st December to show the working of the Industry for the latter half of the year and include the working for the whole year.
