I have on more than one occasion, in the past, drawn attention to the fact that the annual rental due by the Argentina de Pesca, in respect of 500 acres at Grytviken Harbour (£250,) and 30 acres, at Jason Harbour, (£100,) has never been paid in CASH to the Colonial Treasury; it is invariably paid by cheque, and is due, on or before the 1st January, in each year.

2. The payment of this amount of £350, by the Argentina de Pesca by cheque to the Treasurer means that from 3 to 4 months must elapse after the cheque has been received and a receipt issued, before the money is actually received.

3. In 1920, the cheque for the annual rental, was not received by the Colonial Treasurer, until April 1st. (C S. 1017/19).
