Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter No. 633/20 of the 11th. January, 1921 which I received on the 19th. June, with reference to the taking of the Census in the Dependency and my appointment by His Excellency as supervisor.

As it was impossible to know when the forms would arrive I thought it advisable to have the Census taken while there were still the ordinary whaling crews in the Island. I had an old copy of ^{ONE} of the schedules issued for the 1911 Census and had similar forms made and filled in by the managers of the companies.

At present the Island only contains a fraction of the men usually employed; in all there are probably not more than 150 men and the returns obtained would not furnish a correct estimate of the people usually resident here.

Should His Excellency consider it necessary that the Census should be retaken I can do so as the men at present here are likely to remain for some time now.
