It is possible that a better and cheaper site for the erection of the oil storage tanks might be at the R.N. Fuel Depot at the Camber. The Supt. P/M and I inspected yesterday afternoon. However before any definite plans could be drawn up it would be necessary to obtain Admiralty permission for the scheme, I have accordingly drafted following telegram to the Secretary of State for your approval;
