Sir,

I am instructed by the Board of Health to inform you that at a meeting of the Board held on the 20th instant, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

The Board desire to draw the attention of the Administrator to a Report submitted by them on the 19th July 1917 on the Condition of the Roads and Drains of Stanley. The Board now strongly recommend that a properly qualified Engineer be appointed to make a survey of the Roads and Drains with a view to their being brought into a thorough state of efficiency. The Engineer appointed to make the above survey would require also to be capable of undertaking the necessary work for providing the Town of Stanley with an adequate Water Supply, laid down on modern lines.


