President of the Board of Health

Sir.

I wish to bring to your notice the insanitary condition of a private drain at the south end of Philomet Street adjoining the premises of Mr. John Walsh and Mr. David Carey. I have spoken to the owner of these premises, to have them seen to.

- 2) The Drain from urinal of the Globe Hotel empties itself into an open drain in Ross Road, and is very objectionable, this matter I laid before the board of Health some time ago, and nothing has been done to remedy it.
- 3) an earth closet adjoins the premises of the Falklands Club, and also a urinal which empties itself into ^{an open drain in} Dury Street, which in my opinion is very unsanitary.
- 4) The Paddock known as the Club Paddock owned by Mr. J. Robson is in an unsanitary condition which in my opinion is caused by leakage from a public drain at the least end of Dury Street.
