War Allowance to hourly Employees, P.W.D.

Reference Numbers. }

I beg to bring forward the following matter for H. E.'s consideration.

Towards the end of last year (about Novr.) the Falkland Is. Co. increased their war allowance from 3/- to 6/- per week for all hourly men.

At the present time the Government pay a war allowance of 3/- per week to all hourly men in the employ of the P.W. Department.

I now have been requested by the men to increase the war allowance to that paid by the Falkland Is. Co. viz. 6/- per week. I should be glad to know if H. E. can see his way to give approval for this increase.

The present cost of living is very high and it would appear will be so for some time to come.
